

A Letter from the Director

It is a pleasure and an honor to address you as the Auburn Public Library Director. As many of you know, I grew up in Lewiston and came to this library often. It amazes me to see how the small Carnegie building I knew as a child has been transformed into a generous and beautiful space that reflects the commitment of the Auburn and Minot communities to superior library services for its residents and the region.

My thanks go to my predecessor, Lynn Lockwood, for all she did to help make this library a model for this area and the State. Her ability to understand the rapidly changing library environment and to set the stage for this library to adapt has been extraordinary. She has left us a library with a great deal of respect in the community, a wonderful staff, a well-maintained building, and as a leader in collaborations and innovations. My thanks also to the Trustees for sharing Lynn's vision and supporting it. I also appreciate what you, our supporters, have done to make this a reality. I intend to build upon the foundation that has been laid by Lynn and those who have gone before us.

Since I came to the Library at the very end of the fiscal year, I cannot claim much influence in the year's accomplishments. I am very happy to report, though, that the Library had a very successful year. Here are some interesting figures:

- ♦ Average daily visits: 750 (no change)
- ♦ Internet visits: 90,000 (17% increase)
- Circulation: 241,000 items (2% increase overall, including a 17% increase in down loadable eBooks and audios)
- ♦ Program attendance: 16,200 (a 3% increase)
- ♦ Study rooms: 1,564 uses (a 23% increase)
- Media Lab (Nov. –Jun.): 208 sessions booked, 367 hours (teen usage is the highest)

These figures suggest that the Library reaches out to a varied and active audience. We are providing the materials and resources they are looking for and we have an excellent staff to support them in every way possible.

My sincerest thanks to you all. I'm looking forward to a long and successful tenure here.

2012-2013 Highlights

Collaboration with the Lewiston Public Library. In September 2012 our library partnered with the Lewiston Public Library on a joint website known as LibraryLA.org. Everything on this site can be accessed from your own home with your joint Lewiston-Auburn library card. There you can link to your account, conduct research, discover programs at either library and more. In this spirit of cooperation the two libraries have also agreed to semi-annual joint board meetings and including a trustee from each library at one another's board meetings.



Technology. The APL Media Lab was completed and received significant local, regional, and national attention. The Lab is being used by all ages. Customers are using the lab for both professional and personal purposes from scanning genealogy documents to creating video demos to enhance a career.

Survey. The biennial survey of the Library's customers was conducted. Our customers overwhelmingly approve of the job we do. We have listened and we will be working hard to upgrade our public

computer system with new hardware and software. Funding for the new equipment was approved in the FY14 budget.

Programming: We have expanded our programming significantly this past year. We have reached out to new audiences through our small business collaborations, the Teen Space, and the Media Lab. Our partnership with SCORE has allowed us to provide direct consulting with small businesses. Our commitment to early literacy includes special cooperation with Maine Department of Education's "Literacy for ME" program which resulted in a Family Literacy night. Teens have been introduced to the "Maker Space" concept which encourages cooperation and creativity in a variety of ways to learn skills and design freely. There is always something going on here and it is always interesting.






